HOW DO I DECORATE MY PIECE?

Decorate your piece in any way that represents your connection to God and SJUMC. You are welcome to just use colors. For example, a light blue stream can represent Living Water. Arlene and Mindy are available to help with inspiration.

What does the church mean to you? Here are some ideas:

- ☑ Singing/choir: Music note, title of favorite hymn, ear (for music)
- ☑ Garden Angels: sprig from artificial plant, seed packet, hands (at work)
- ☑ Exercise/Sports: piece of water bottle, collage of exercise activity, feet (at play)
- ☑ Small groups/Bible study: favorite Bible verse, sunshine, heart (for God)

WHAT SIZE IS EACH PIECE?

The sizes vary, but most foam board pieces are a parallelogram shape approximately 4"x 12".



WHAT KIND OF ART SUPPLIES SHOULD I USE?

Please use lightweight supplies such as: pen, ink, paint, cutouts from magazines, knickknacks, etc.

We will have art supplies available at each session. **You are welcome and encouraged to bring any special items that you'd like to include on your piece.**

SHOULD I MAKE AN INDIVIDUAL OR FAMILY PIECE?

You decide if you would like your piece to represent you and/or your family. Each member of a family is welcome to complete a separate piece if they'd like to.

CAN I BRING THE PIECE HOME?

If a church member is homebound and unable to come to the church, a piece can be delivered to them to decorate. It's important that we receive each piece back, as they have been hand-cut to fit together in a unique way.

WILL I HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO DESCRIBE MY PIECE?

Yes! Each piece will be numbered. When you prepare your piece, you will be given a sheet with the corresponding number. Please write your name(s), and a short description of what your piece represents.

WILL OUR PASSED SAINTS BE RECOGNIZED?

Yes, we will honor all members who have passed with a special piece.

WHEN WILL THE BODY OF CHRIST CROSS BE COMPLETED?

We are aiming for December 2022.
